



What is a net return?

The net return measures the amount by which an investment option has risen or fallen over a period. It is useful in helping you compare your investment option against the other 15 investment options that Vision Super offers. It is also a way to compare one super fund against another.

You would probably only have received the actual return published if you had made no transactions on your account during the year. If any contributions were paid to your account, you rolled money over during the year or had a benefit payment paid from your account, the return you receive could be higher or lower than that shown in the investment return tables.

Any of these transactions would change the actual return on your account, depending upon the unit price that applied on the day.
